**Drinking Water Subcommittee of the Bay-Delta Public
Advisory Committee invites nominations for membership**

The CALFED Bay-Delta Program is seeking volunteers for a subcommittee that will work on ways to enhance the quality of Californians' drinking water.

The mission of the Drinking Water Subcommittee is to provide policy advice and leadership to the newly formed Bay-Delta Public Advisory Committee on implementation of CALFED's Drinking Water Quality Program.

The subcommittee will recommend courses of action, through the Public Advisory Committee, to CALFED agencies on treatment technology, alternative water sources, conveyance improvements, storage and water-system operations to meet CALFED's goal of continuous improvement in the quality of water in the Bay-Delta watershed.

The committee already has seven members, including five from the Public Advisory Committee. They are co-chairs Greg Gartrell of the Contra Costa Water District and Marguerite Young of Clean Water Action/Clean Water Fund; Martha Guzman of the United Farm Workers; Tim Quinn of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, and Tom Zuckerman of the Central Delta Water Agency. Two other members represent urban water agencies -- Pankaj Parekh of the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, and Walt Wadlow, Santa Clara Valley Water District.

The Drinking Water Subcommittee wants to complete its membership with a preference for persons with expertise in one or more of the following areas:

- Medicine/public health
- Consumer affairs
- Domestic and industrial wastewater
- Watershed source control
- Treatment technology
- Recycled water
- Small water systems
- Resource and/or health economics
